

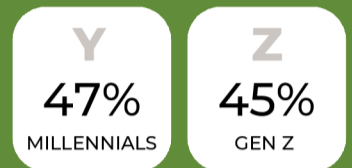
# Youth Perspectives on Governance in the Philippines.



Youth in the Philippines report moderate levels of trust in their government, with concerns centered around a lack of accountability.

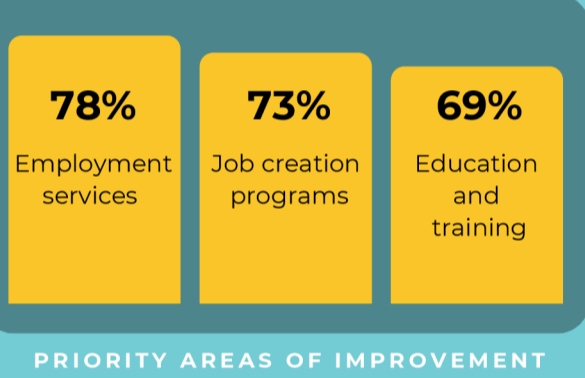


**2 in 5** Filipinos trust the government to act in the best interest of the public.

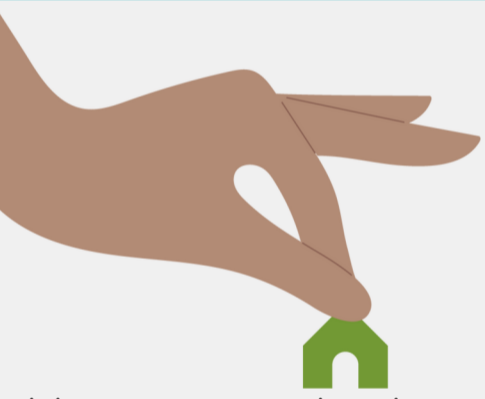


Over 2 in 5 Filipinos feel it's safe to express opinions on government policies and issues affecting the Youth.

Filipinos are looking for more support from employment services and job creation programs.

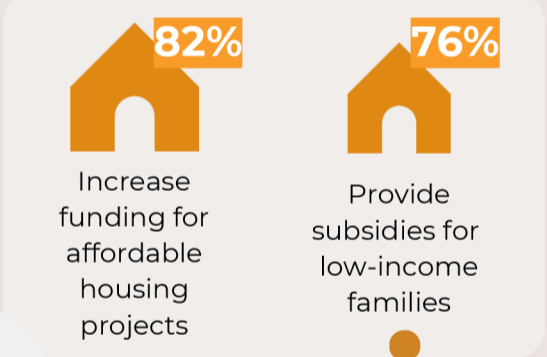


Filipino Youth are particularly concerned about job creation and underemployment, with government initiatives falling short of expectations.

PRIORITY AREAS OF IMPROVEMENT

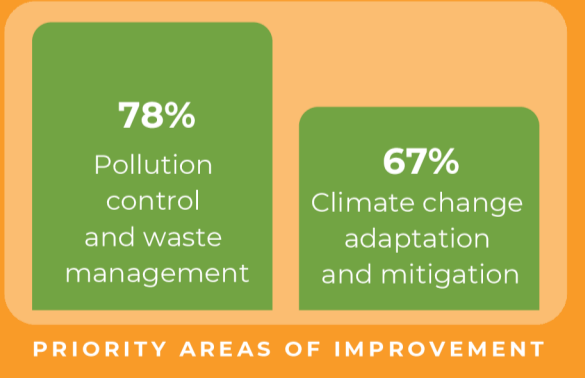


Females are more likely to prioritize this **80%** vs **71%** among males.
