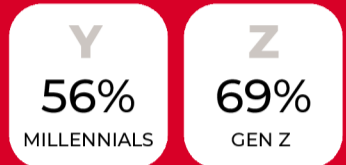


Youth Perspectives on Governance in Singapore.



Youth in Singapore report high levels of trust in their government, driven by strong government engagement and transparent policies.

Postgrads are more likely to feel safe.
76% vs 58% among Bachelor's degree and below.



Feel it's safe to express opinions on government policies and issues affecting the Youth.

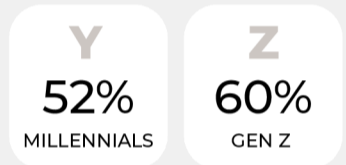
Males are more likely to prioritise Entrepreneurship support.
49% vs 39% among females.



Despite the country's strong economic performance, Youth in Singapore are concerned with high competition in the job market and a lack of job opportunities.

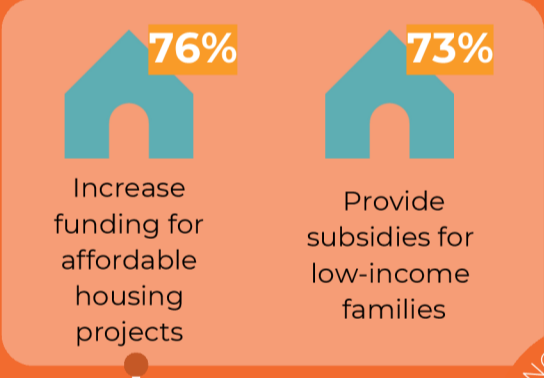


PRIORITY AREAS OF IMPROVEMENT



Singaporeans are satisfied with job security in Singapore.

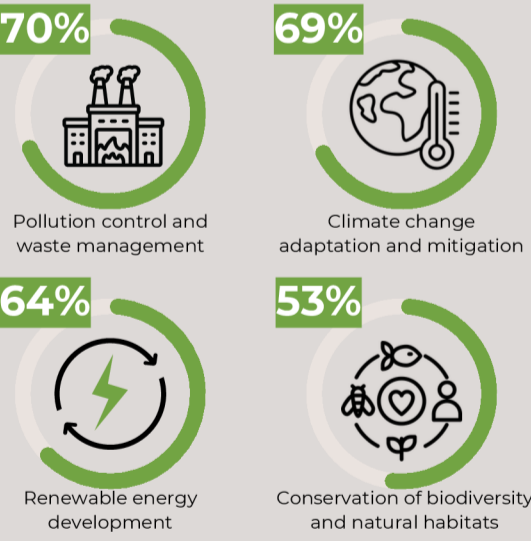
PRIORITY AREAS OF IMPROVEMENT

Housing affordability remains a significant concern among Singaporean Youth, with less than half surveyed satisfied due to rising property costs.



PRIORITY AREAS OF IMPROVEMENT

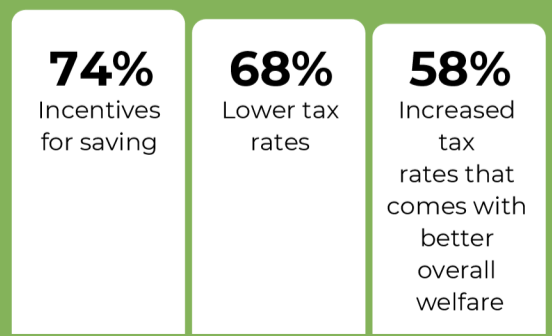
Environmental sustainability is a key priority for Singaporean Youth, with a focus on pollution control and climate change adaptation.



Youth in Singapore express strong support for reforms to address high tax rates, hoping for government incentives to encourage saving and measures to lower tax rates.
