Vietnamese Youth feel safe to express opinions on government policies and feel their government acts in their best interest.



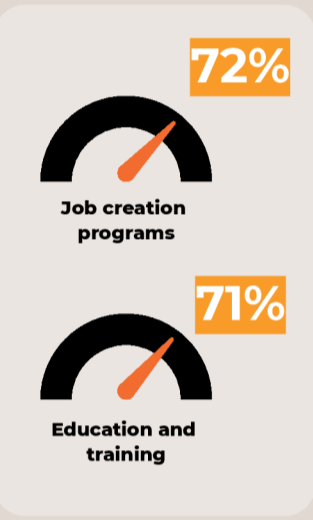

PRIORITY AREAS OF IMPROVEMENT



**Males are more likely to prioritize job creation**  
76% males vs 66% females.

Youth in Vietnam express concerns about job availability and seek more job creation programs from their government.



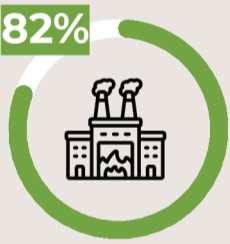
**Provide subsidies for low-income families** is top priority for Vietnamese Youth.

Housing affordability remains a challenge for many Youth, with property prices and rents cited as their biggest concern.

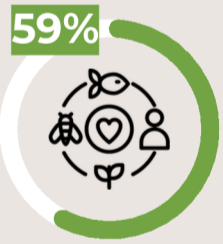

PRIORITY AREAS OF IMPROVEMENT

**18-24 years-olds are more likely to prioritize Conservation of biodiversity and natural habitats.**  
67% vs 56% among 25-43 years-olds.



Vietnamese Youth say lack of public awareness around protecting the environment is the biggest challenge in their country.



Youth in Vietnam call for improved transparency in public spending, tax policies, and government accountability to strengthen trust.
